CODE OF CONDUCT

As part of the 2022 Registration, all parents/guardians have agreed to the following terms:

✓ **AGREED**

I will be a positive role model for my player and instill the principles of good sportsmanship and team play.

✓ **AGREED**

I will make certain my player shows respect for all other players, spectators, coaches, and umpires.

✓ **AGREED**

I will treat all other players, spectators, coaches, and umpires fairly and with respect.

✓ **AGREED**

I will be responsible for and reiterate to my guests that they should respect all players, spectators, coaches, and umpires.

✓ **AGREED**

I, along with my guests, will not cause or escalate a confrontation with umpires, coaches, or other spectators during any PYBSA event.

✓ **AGREED**

I, along with my guests, will not "coach" or "umpire" from the sidelines. Players need support from spectators, direction from coaches, and to respect umpire authority.

✓ **AGREED**

Though competition is important, I will remind myself and others that sports should be fun and positive for every player, win or lose.

✓ **AGREED**

I understand that any violation of the Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action for myself, my player, and/or my guests.

MAJOR VIOLATIONS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND WILL RESULT IMMEDIATELY IN A TWO GAME SUSPENSION.

ANY ADDITIONAL VIOLATION WILL RESULT IN AN EXPULSION FROM ALL PYBSA ACTIVITIES.

Major violations include:

- a player, coach, or fan being ejected by an umpire
- physical or verbal abuse
- any damage to our fields and/or personal property
